WHAT? IS WOOL4SCHOOL?

Wool4School is an annual student design competition encouraging budding fashion designers to use Merino wool for innovative thinking and creative design. First launched in Australia in 2012, Wool4School now involves over 100,000 students worldwide.

This year, students are asked to repair, renew, repurpose and innovate. Take what's old and make it new! Design a unique outfit that blends both old and new, featuring pre-loved items, using wool design techniques and incorporating a minimum of 70% Merino wool. Investigate how you can harness the amazing qualities of wool to design an outfit for your end user.







THE:BRIEF

DESIGN A UNIQUE OUTFIT THAT BLENDS BOTH OLD AND NEW, FEATURING PRE-LOVED ITEMS TRANSFORMED WITH WOOL DESIGN TECHNIQUES.

Redesign and restore a vintage, retro or pre-owned garment to give it new life or combine wool items that would otherwise be discarded. You may include vibrant stitchwork, visible mending, embroidery, crochet, patchwork and beyond. Let your creativity run free!

Your outfit should consist of 1-4 pieces and must be made up of at least 70% Merino wool. Your end user could be someone you know, or someone in the public eye. You could even design the outfit for yourself! Explore and investigate how your outfit will harness the amazing qualities of wool to meet your design's end user.









HOW? TO PARTICIPATE

EACH STUDENT WHO WISHES TO SUBMIT AN ENTRY MUST REGISTER FOR THE COMPETITION. TEACHERS ARE NO LONGER ABLE TO SUBMIT ON BEHALF OF STUDENTS.



REGISTRATION

To enter Wool4School, fill out the registration form. Once you have registered, you will be sent an email with a confirmation link. Click the link in the email to confirm your registration. Students must register individually to receive important information about the competition. If you participated in last year's competition, you don't need to register again. Simply log in and update your details.



LEARNING RESOURCES

Go to your dashboard to review Wool4School information. You should complete the Wool Appreciation Course for a better understanding of introductory wool knowledge.



DELIVERABLES



The deliverables are different for each category and judging criteria. Find out what is required for your age group to complete an entry.



SUBMIT YOUR ENTRY



Submit your design through the dashboard. Note, teachers are no longer able to submit on behalf of their students. When received, an expert panel of judges will evaluate your entry against the competition criteria to determine the winners.






